I would highlight our guest speaker this year, Marc Reeves, Chair of Focus Birmingham, the organisation known to most of us as the local charity providing support, care, advice and guidance to all those affected by sight loss across the whole of Birmingham.

Marc previously was editor of the Birmingham Mail and the Birmingham Post and launch editor of the BirminghamLive website, now one of the largest in the country. These publications are central to BTNBVI operations

As a campaigning newspaper editor, he worked with community organisations, businesses and charities across the city for two decades, raising money for good causes, demanding justice for the victims of the

Birmingham pub bombings, and holding local and national politicians to account.

We still operate on substantially the same basis as we did fifty years ago but the world is changing (as I hope Marc will highlight).
